Gift Options

LIFE INSURANCE

You can make a gift of life insurance by designating The Arc as the owner or beneficiary

of a policy. When The Arc is named the owner of a paid-up policy or a policy with internal cash value on which future payments are owed, you may claim a charitable deduction.

BEQUESTS

You can provide an enduring gift to The Arc through your Will or Living Trust. By including The Arc in your estate plans, you can specify that some or all of your assets come to us after your lifetime. At that time, the assets will pass to The Arc, and your estate can take a charitable deduction for the amount of your bequest.

RETIREMENT PLAN ASSETS

You can name The Arc as survivor beneficiary on your qualified retirement plan. By doing so, the gift becomes exempt from estate tax and thus the entire gift will go to The Arc.









CHARITABLE LEAD TRUST

You can establish a charitable lead trust by transferring cash or assets to a trust for the benefit of The Arc. Your trust then provides

annual income to The Arc for a fixed period.





CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUST

You may create a charitable remainder trust for The Arc by placing assets into a trust that will provide you a tax deduction and generate income today. The remainder of the trust passes to The Arc as a legacy gift.
