"Step Up For the Arc" is an annual statewide Walkathon of The Arc, the state's largest non-profit advocacy and service organization supporting people with developmental disabilities and their families. The event, which is a 1.5 mile fun walk and sanctioned Grand Prix (500 pts) 5K race on a flat paved, and scenic course, aims to raise awareness for children and adults living with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Somerset County.

Registration fees are \$20 per runner, \$18 per USATF runner, \$15 per student runner, and \$10 per walker which are waived for participants raising \$50 or more. Student runners younger than age 18 are free. Online registration is encouraged. All ages are welcome.

The event will include morning activities hosted by race sponsor, Contract All and Furino & Sons Brothers Four. Registered dieticians from Village Shop Right of Somerset and Hillsborough will be on hand to share samples of breakfast quinoa and fruit along with take-home recipes. HRC Fitness of Hillsborough will be on hand to warm up the runners and walkers at the start of the race and will host an information table about its fitness facility and Somerville School of Rock's Youth Rock Band will be there to perform the national anthem and a few set lists throughout the morning. The walk will conclude mid-morning with the 12th District Free and Accepted Masons hosting a free barbecue picnic for all participants at the event,

Volunteers are needed. The Arc is hosting a'Buddy Walk' for the event. Volunteers will be paired with persons served the organization as they take part in the 1.5-mile fun walk. Afterward, volunteers can spend time with these clients as well.
