The Arc Hosts Successful Angel Gala Celebrating New Partnership with The Achievement Center at Raritan Valley





"The Achievement Center", which piloted in September of 2015 is a transitional post-secondary program for students with intellectual and developmental disabilities which provides young students with intellectual and developmental disabilities the opportunity to participate fully in a college experience at Raritan Valley Community College while receiving additional support from The Arc, allowing them to have a fully integrated college experience. The event was emceed for the eighth year by Assemblyman Jack


